




**Waco-McLennan County Public Health District COVID-19
UPDATE AS OF July 18, 2020 at 4:00 pm.**

**81 New Cases of COVID-19 have been confirmed as of this update
There are 2 fatalities to report, with a total of 24 fatalities to date.
The Total Number of Cases to Date is 3,291.
There are 1,377 estimated active cases.
1,890 estimated cases have recovered.**

(July 18, 2020) The Waco-McLennan County Public Health District has confirmed 81 new cases of COVID-19. The total number of cases is 3,291, which includes 1,890 estimated recovered, 24 deaths, and 1,377 estimated active cases.

- 71 cases are hospitalized
 - Of the 71 hospitalized, 54 cases are McLennan County residents. This information is being provided to inform residents about the use of local hospital resources.
 - 15 cases are on ventilators.

Age groups for July 18th release:

- 5 cases are in the 0-10 age range.
- 8 cases are in the 11-19 age range.
- 27 cases are in the 20-29 age range.
- 18 cases are in the 30-39 age range.
- 6 cases are in the 40-49 age range.
- 8 cases are in the 50-59 age range.
- 9 cases are the 60 and above age range.
