

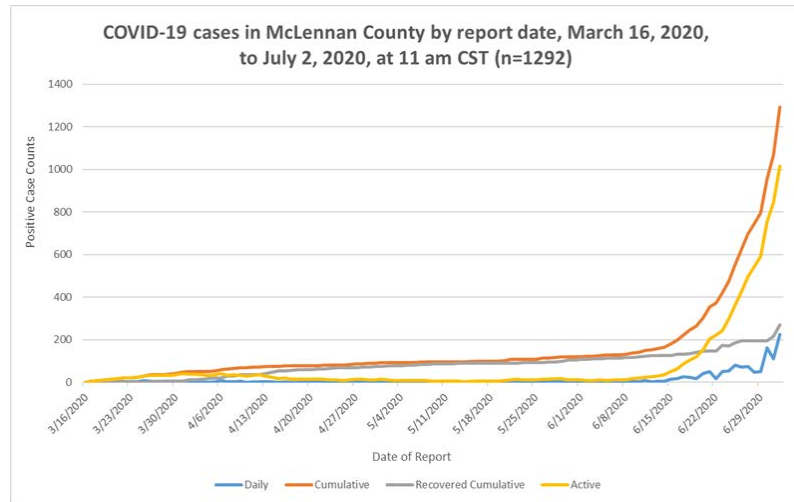


**Waco-McLennan County Public Health District COVID-19
UPDATE AS OF July 2, 2020 at 3:00 pm.**

**224 New Cases of COVID-19 have been confirmed as of this update.
The Total Number of Cases to Date is 1292.
There are 1015 active cases.
268 cases have recovered.**

(July 2, 2020) The Waco-McLennan County Public Health District has received 224 new cases of COVID-19. The total number of cases is 1292, which includes 268 recovered, 9 deaths, and 1015 active cases.

- 36 cases are hospitalized
 - 26 cases are McLennan County residents
 - 4 cases are on ventilators
- 268 cases have recovered. There are 1015 active cases.
- The Texas Department of State Health Services is monitoring all active cases and direct contacts.
- 9 deaths in McLennan County.



Age groups for July 2nd release:

- 13 cases are in the 0-10 age range.
- 32 cases are in the 11-19 age range.
- 53 cases are in the 20-29 age range.
- 32 cases are in the 30-39 age range.
- 44 cases are in in the 40-49 age range.
- 27 cases are in the 50-59 age range.
- 23 cases in the 60 and above age range.
