




**Waco-McLennan County Public Health District COVID-19
UPDATE AS OF July 20, 2020 at 4:00 pm.**

**59 New Cases of COVID-19 have been confirmed as of this update
The Total Number of Cases to Date is 3472.
There are 1,503 estimated active cases.
1,945 estimated cases have recovered.**

(July 20, 2020) The Waco-McLennan County Public Health District has confirmed 59 new cases of COVID-19. The total number of cases is 3,472, which includes 1,945 estimated recovered, 24 deaths, and 1,503 estimated active cases.

- 77 cases are hospitalized
 - Of the 77 hospitalized, 58 cases are McLennan County residents. This information is being provided to inform residents about the use of local hospital resources.
 - 14 cases are on ventilators.



Age groups for July 20th release:

- 0 cases are in the 1 and under range.
- 1 case is in the 1-9 age range.
- 5 cases are in the 10-19 age range.
- 13 cases are in the 20-29 age range.
- 10 cases are in the 30-39 age range.
- 8 cases are in the 40-49 age range.
- 6 cases are in the 50-59 age range.
- 1 case is in the 60-64 age range.
- 4 cases are in the 65-69 age range.
- 3 cases are in the 70-74 age range.
- 3 cases are in the 75-79 age range.
- 5 cases are in the 80 and above age range.
