




**Waco-McLennan County Public Health District COVID-19
UPDATE AS OF July 3, 2020 at 3:00 pm.**

**271 New Cases of COVID-19 have been confirmed as of this update.
The Total Number of Cases to Date is 1563.
There are 1258 active cases.
296 cases have recovered.**

(July 3, 2020) The Waco-McLennan County Public Health District has received 271 new cases of COVID-19. The total number of cases is 1563, which includes 296 recovered, 9 deaths, and 1258 active cases.

- 37 cases are hospitalized
 - 28 cases are McLennan County residents
 - 5 cases are on ventilators
- 296 cases have recovered. There are 1258 active cases.
- The Texas Department of State Health Services is monitoring all active cases and direct contacts.
- 9 deaths in McLennan County.



Age groups for July 3rd release:

- 10 cases are in the 0-10 age range.
- 41 cases are in the 11-19 age range.
- 72 cases are in the 20-29 age range.
- 41 cases are in the 30-39 age range.
- 40 cases are in in the 40-49 age range.
- 31 cases are in the 50-59 age range.
- 36 cases in the 60 and above age range.
