


**Waco-McLennan County Public Health District COVID-19  
UPDATE AS OF July 6, 2020 at 3:00 pm.**

**187 New Cases of COVID-19 including cases from the Holiday weekend have been confirmed as of this update.  
The Total Number of Cases to Date is 1871.  
There are 1550 active cases.  
308 cases have recovered.**

(July 6, 2020) The Waco-McLennan County Public Health District has confirmed 187 new cases of COVID-19. This number includes cases from the Holiday weekend. The total number of cases is 1871, which includes 308 recovered, 13 deaths, and 1550 active cases.

- 34 cases are hospitalized
  - 25 cases are McLennan County residents
  - 6 cases are on ventilators
- 308 cases have recovered. There are 1550 active cases.
- Currently, the Public Health District is monitoring 66 cases. The Texas Department of State Health Services has taken on the monitoring function for 274 cases.
- 13 deaths in McLennan County.



**Age groups for July 6<sup>th</sup> release:**

- 8 cases are in the 0-10 age range.
- 25 cases are in the 11-19 age range.
- 50 cases are in the 20-29 age range.
- 20 cases are in the 30-39 age range.
- 31 cases are in in the 40-49 age range.
- 25 cases are in the 50-59 age range.
- 28 cases are the 60 and above age range.
