




**Waco-McLennan County Public Health District COVID-19  
UPDATE AS OF July 7, 2020 at 3:00 pm.**

**173 New Cases of COVID-19 have been confirmed as of this update.  
The Total Number of Cases to Date is 2044.  
There are 1723 active cases.  
308 cases have recovered.**

(July 7, 2020) The Waco-McLennan County Public Health District has confirmed 173 new cases of COVID-19. The total number of cases is 2044, which includes 308 recovered, 13 deaths, and 1723 active cases.

- 42 cases are hospitalized
  - 34 cases are McLennan County residents
  - 9 cases are on ventilators
- 308 cases have recovered. There are 1723 active cases.
- Currently, the Public Health District is monitoring 54 cases. The Texas Department of State Health Services has taken on the monitoring function for 274 cases.
- 13 deaths in McLennan County.



**Age groups for July 7<sup>th</sup> release:**

- 9 cases are in the 0-10 age range.
- 24 cases are in the 11-19 age range.
- 42 cases are in the 20-29 age range.
- 24 cases are in the 30-39 age range.
- 24 cases are in the 40-49 age range.
- 29 cases are in the 50-59 age range.
- 21 cases are the 60 and above age range.
