


**Waco-McLennan County Public Health District COVID-19
UPDATE AS OF July 9, 2020 at 3:00 pm.**

**155 New Cases of COVID-19 have been confirmed as of this update.
The Total Number of Cases to Date is 2438.
There are 2010 active cases.
413 cases have recovered.**

(July 9, 2020) The Waco-McLennan County Public Health District has confirmed 155 new cases of COVID-19. The total number of cases is 2438, which includes 413 recovered, 15 deaths, and 2010 active cases.

- 45 cases are hospitalized
 - Of the 45 hospitalized, 35 cases are McLennan County residents. This information is being provided to inform residents about the use of local hospital resources.
 - 10 cases are on ventilators
- 413 cases have recovered. There are 2010 active cases.
- Currently, the Public Health District is monitoring 20 cases. The Texas Department of State Health Services has taken on the monitoring function for 500 cases.
- 15 deaths in McLennan County.



Age groups for July 9th release:

- 6 cases are in the 0-10 age range.
- 17 cases are in the 11-19 age range.
- 36 cases are in the 20-29 age range.
- 22 cases are in the 30-39 age range.
- 17 cases are in the 40-49 age range.
- 21 cases are in the 50-59 age range.
- 35 cases are the 60 and above age range.
- 1 case is unknown at this time.
