Free COVID-19 Testing in McLennan County

WACO, TEXAS (September 15, 2020) The Waco-McLennan County Office of Emergency Management, the Waco-McLennan County Public Health District and the Texas Department of Emergency Management are partnering to offer free COVID-19 testing sites in September and October. There will be one walk-up sites and two drive-through sites. All testing sites are free. Registration is required for the drive-through sites. If you suspect you may have the Coronavirus (COVID-19), or think you may have been exposed to it, you are encouraged to be tested. You do not have to have symptoms to be tested. All testing is done with a cheek swab test.
