S. 26th Street To Be Closed Next Week for Sewer Work

WACO, TX (September 18, 2020) – A contractor will close S. 26th Street between Clay Ave. and Burnett Ave. beginning Monday, September 21, 2020 and ending Friday, September 25, 2020 for sewer main replacement. Detour will be in place to S. 24th Street and S. 28th Street.

Drivers are encouraged to plan accordingly and find an alternate route for those traveling in the area during this time to minimize delays and traffic congestion.

Safety is a top priority at City of Waco, when driving through a work zone, some simple steps to take are: slow down, pay attention, avoid distractions such as cell phones, be patient and plan ahead.
