Connections 2045: The Waco Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) outlines mobility needs for the Waco Metropolitan Area through 2045. The MTP serves as the blueprint from which transportation projects to address those needs are developed. The draft MTP is available for public review and comment via the MPO website at www.waco-texas.gov/cms-mpo under the page for plans and programs.

In addition to the MTP, the Waco MPO is also soliciting comments for preliminary recommendations for the Fort Worth to Laredo High Speed Transportation Study.

The MPO will be conducting 2 public informational meetings next week to share the draft MTP and High Speed Transportation Study and to solicit comments regarding proposed recommendations. These meetings are scheduled as follows:
