2017 Waco Water Quality Report Now Available

Waco, Texas (July 3, 2018) – The City of Waco has released its 2017 Water Quality Report. The report is available online at: [**www.WacoWaterQuality.com**](http://www.WacoWaterQuality.com)

The report is also available at City Hall, the Water Office (425 Franklin Avenue) and Waco – McLennan County Library branches. Customers preferring to have a printed copy of the Water Quality Report mailed to their residence may request one by calling (254) 299-CITY (2489).

The Water Quality Report, also known as a Consumer Confidence Report, is published annually and made available to all customers receiving water service from the city. The report lists any contaminants found in the drinking water, as well as disinfectant levels throughout the previous year (2017).

In addition to water quality data, the Water Quality Report contains water conservation tips and other information relevant to the water system.

Water Quality Reports, or Consumer Confidence Reports, are mandated by 1996 amendments to the *Safe Drinking Water Act*. All public water suppliers that serve the same people year round (community water systems) are required to provide consumer confidence reports (CCR) to their customers annually.
