

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON ADOPTION OF IMPACT FEES.** The purpose of the hearing is to consider the adoption of an impact fee for water, wastewater and roadways. The proposed maximum impact fee calculations are \$1,804.00 for water, \$3,574.00 for wastewater and \$1,324.00 for roadway per service unit. Any member of the public has the right to speak remotely on the hearing and present evidence for or against the adoption of impact fees.
