



CREATE A MOVING PAPER FISH

YOU'LL NEED:

- 2 pieces of construction paper (colors of your choice)
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Markers



INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Begin with the sheet of paper that you want to be the main color of your fish. Fold one corner into the opposite edge to create a triangle. Cut off the excess. You should end with a perfect square.
2. Fold two corners into the center line to form a kite shape. Unfold, then fold back in half. Cut on the creased edge down to the fold lines halfway down (don't go past the fold lines). Leave a space at the top for the fish head.
3. Unfold. Glue the two uncut pieces together so the fish is now three dimensional.
4. Trim the point off of the head section, so the face is rounded.
5. Cut a heart shape and two ovals with sharp ends; these will be your fins. Glue the heart shape to the back of the fish as a tail fin and glue the ovals on the bottom of each side as the side fins.
6. Use markers to draw eyes on your fish.
7. Hold it up and let it wiggle in your hands, just like a real fish!
