

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-386

WHEREAS, the City had its general election scheduled for May 2020; and

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic caused the general election to be moved to November 2020; and

WHEREAS, on May 29, 2020, Councilperson Dillon Meek (IV) announced that he will be moving on June 1, 2020, to a residence located outside District IV; and

WHEREAS, Article II, Section 3 of the Charter, City of Waco, Texas, provides that a council office is forfeited when the councilperson ceases to reside in the district to which he or she was elected; and

WHEREAS, Article XVI, Section 17 of the Texas Constitution provides that officers shall continue to perform the duties of their offices until their successors shall be duly qualified; and

WHEREAS, the continuity of government is essential,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WACO, TEXAS:

That effective June 1, 2020, there is a vacancy in the position for Council District IV.

That the appointment process for Council District IV is initiated with an application deadline of June 17, 2020.

That the City Secretary shall take all necessary steps to advertise and facilitate the appointment process.

That Dillon Meek shall continue to serve as the councilperson for District IV until his successor is duly appointed and qualified.

That it is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution is passed is open to the public and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by law.
