

**CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION  
RESULTS OF POLICE SERGEANT (GRADE II) PRE-QUALIFYING EXAM**

The following list of candidates took the pre-qualifying, written examination for **Police Sergeant (Grade II)** on **August 21, 2020**. A minimum score of 70 on the written exam shall be considered passing. Those not passing the written exam shall be eliminated from further consideration regarding the Assessment Center process.

Candidates passing the written test with a minimum score of 70 will move on to the Assessment Center portion of the examination. The Assessment Center will be conducted by Steve Griffith Consulting on **September 18, 2020** at the M.C.C. Emergency Services Education Center and will start at **8:00 a.m.**

Candidates will be placed on an eligibility list according to their total score, highest to lowest, derived from the combination of the following – Written Exam @ 60 points, Assessment Center @ 40 points, Seniority in Rank @ a maximum of 10 points, Military Service with Honorable Discharge or Associate’s Degree @ 1 point, Bachelor’s Degree or Master Peace Officer License @ 2 points and Master’s Degree @ 3 points (total maximum score 113). Candidates are eligible only for the highest educational/certification/military points for which they qualify.

**NOTE – Only the test score (not including years of service seniority points) is being posted at this time. Seniority in rank points will be added after the assessment center.**
