COVID-19 Case Counts for April 21, 2020

- 1 new case
- 78 total cases
- 13 active cases
- 61 recovered cases
- 2 cases are hospitalized and in critical condition
- 2,180 tests have been completed since 4-19-20

- Council IR, Tuesday, March 3rd
- Exec team Monday, March 9th
 - EOC issued preparedness document

Update on City's Emergency Response Plan

- COVID-19 Incident
 - City Manager closed certain City Facilities
 - Saturday, March 14th
 - Mayor issued emergency declaration
 - Tuesday, March 17th
 - Declaration “activates the City’s emergency plan”
 - Emergency plan (III)(B)(6)(b)(6) requires Emergency Operations Center (EOC) activation


