



Phase 1	Wastewater Line	1/20/20	7/16/2020
Phase 2	Vehicular Pavement (completed, not fully open)	3/10/20	Current estimate: September 2020
Phase 3	Sidewalks/ Pedestrian Pavement	5/21/20	Current estimate: January 2021
Phase 4	Structures, Landscaping and Crosswalk	8/19/20	Under review


